



**General Guidelines for Weekly Service:**

- Trash and recycling are normally picked up every Friday.
- Trash should be placed in plastic bags or receptacle/can of 35 gallons or less, weighing less than 35 pounds.
- Trash and recyclables may not be comingled. They must be placed in separate containers.
- Place all materials at curbside by 6:30 AM because the trucks may change routes and pick up times may change.
- Pickup will take place on a Saturday when a holiday is during the week. The 2019 holidays affecting pickup are New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas and 2020 New Year’s Day.
- Additional recycling bins are available from the town hall for \$10 per bin.

<p><b>Recyclable</b></p>	<p>Corrugated cardboard and boxboard (cereal, soda, etc.,) must be flattened, bundled and tied in 3’x4’ bundles. Keep dry.                  Glass – All colors, clean, unbroken, labels on okay - soda, beer, wine &amp; liquor bottles, juice &amp; food containers and catsup bottles, etc. (No broken glass)                  Lead Acid Batteries                  Newspaper, magazines, catalogs &amp; office paper – Bundled, tied or contained in a box or in a grocery bag. Keep dry. May be placed next to bin.                  Paint (empty cans or dried contents)                  Plastics with recycling symbols 1 through 7. Rinsed.                  • No empty plastic bags. They should be recycled at stores.                  • No Styrofoam; Styrofoam is not recyclable.                  • No hard plastic buckets.                  Tin cans rinsed. Empty aerosol cans. Aluminum cans and foil rinsed.</p>
<p><b>Trash</b></p>	<p>Curtain rods &amp; wire hangers                  Non-recyclable Glass – Mirrors, ceramic cups &amp; plates, clay flower pots, crystal, light bulbs, window glass, heat-resistant ovenware &amp; drinking glass Broken Glass (Please wrap broken glass before placing in trash.)                  Styrofoam and hard plastic buckets. Styrofoam is not recyclable.</p>
